A. Role Performed at WIRC:

As Chairman of AI at WIRC Committee – Key Highlights:

- Conducted **50+ batches** of AI – Level 1 and 3 batches of Level 2 at WIRC BKC premises, training over **3,000 Chartered Accountants**, thereby building structured AI capacity within the profession.
- **“TechEdge Series”** comprising **20+ virtual knowledge sessions** to keep members updated with emerging AI developments. Recordings are available on the official WIRC YouTube channel for wider accessibility.
- Successfully hosted the **National Conference** on Artificial Intelligence with the theme **“Growth through Artificial Intelligence and Network (gAIIn)”**, attended by 550+ participants, fostering dialogue on innovation, governance, and responsible adoption of AI in practice.
- Published the book **“AI & CA – Essential Tools for Today’s CA Practice”**, with **5,000+ copies** circulated, providing practical guidance for technology integration in professional engagements.
- Initiated **Corporate tie-ups** for structured AI training programs, enhancing employability and practical exposure for CA members in industry.
- Commenced discussions for a proposed Memorandum of Understanding (**MoU**) with the **Government of Maharashtra** to promote ethical and responsible use of Artificial Intelligence.
- Facilitated 1–2 days **AI Workshops for CA Students** under WICASA at Branch Level, strengthening early-stage technological readiness among future professionals.

As Chairman of Research and Exposure Draft Committee – Key Highlights:

- Published an **E-Compilation on Reporting under CARO (FY 2024-25)** covering CARO disclosures of **30 listed companies** across diverse sectors. The publication serves as a practical reference document for members and is available on the WIRC website.
- Launched and promoted a **Branch-Level Research Competition**, encouraging members to undertake and submit structured, evidence-based research papers, thereby fostering a culture of analytical and technical excellence within the profession.
- Encouraged and supported **Research-oriented** academic pursuits, including Ph.D. initiatives by Chartered Accountants, reinforcing the role of the profession in contributing to policy, governance, and nation-building through scholarly work.
- Facilitated **submission of technical suggestions and representations** to ICAI Head office on various Exposure Drafts relating to Accounting Standards, Standards on Auditing, and Ind AS, etc ensuring that members’ practical perspectives are reflected in standard-setting processes.

Other initiatives at WIRC – Key Highlights:

- Curated a **Virtual Bank Audit Help Desk** during the Bank Audit Season to addressing more than **40 real-time queries of members**, providing structured guidance and timely technical support during a critical professional assignment period.
- Setting up an **Income Tax Return and Tax Audit Help Desk** at the WIRC level during the tax compliance season. WIRC played a proactive role in compiling members' representations and channelling them to the Income Tax Department through ICAI Head Office, thereby strengthening institutional advocacy and grievance redressal.
- As Vice Chairman at Committee for Members in Industry, organised **Industry-specific technical sessions for Members in Industry**, focusing on sectoral developments, regulatory updates, and emerging compliance frameworks, thereby enhancing domain specialization and practical relevance.

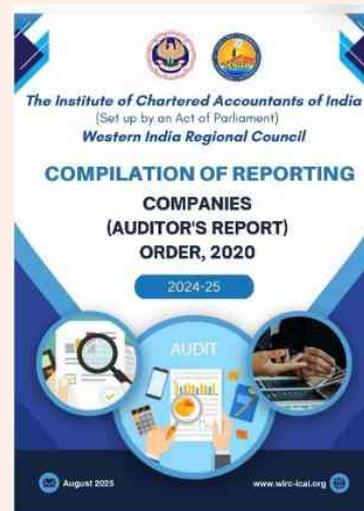
